Aidhm an Pholasaí

Glactar leis go forleathan i measc pobal an Choláiste gur cuid lárnach de íomhá an Choláiste é an éide scoile agus ar an mbonn sin tá polasaí éide scoile i bhfeidhm. Glactar freisin go gcruthaíonn an éide scoile pobal aontaithe agus go gcuireann sé le spiorad an choláisteachais.

Ina theannta sin tá feidhm ag an bpolasaí seo ag cinntiú go bhfuil na scoláirí ag teacht ar scoil gléasta go cuí d'imeachtaí laethúil na scoile agus i riocht nach gcuirfeadh iad ná éinne i mbaol, de réir mar a leagtar amach i gCód Iompair na scoile freisin.

Students, parents, teachers and The Board of Management were involved in the formation of this policy. This policy is linked to the Code of Discipline of the Coláiste.

The Aim of this Policy

It is commonly accepted amongst the whole school community that the school uniform plays a central role in portraying the school image and on this basis the school uniform policy is being implemented. It is also accepted that the school uniform creates a united community and contributes to the spirit of collegiality.

In addition, this policy applies to ensure that the students are coming to school dressed appropriately for the school's daily activities and in a way that would not put them or any other in danger, as laid out in the school's Code of Behaviour also.

The School Uniform:

(In effect for 6th Years in schoolyear 2025-26 and henceforth).

A. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th Years

A. The Formal Uniform:

Plain black pants without any logo

Green school jumper with crest.

White shirt/blouse

All black shoes

A black plain jacket

B. The PE Gear for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Years

School hoodie with crest (Black & Green).

Plain black track suit pants with school logo.

Black school crested polo T-shirt.

A plain black body warmer (May be worn under the polo shirt during cold weather)

All black runners

B. The PE Gear for 4th, 5th & 6th Years

Half-zip school jumper with school crest (Black & Green)

All other items as for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Years, see above.

Bliain 6 2024-25

Gan éide scoile más mian leo ach a bheith gléasta go réasúnta, praiticiúil don scoil ar chuma duine oibre proifisiúnta. Iarrtar ar scoláirí an éide scoile foirmeálta a choimeád do ócáidí oifigiúla scoile.

Cur i bhFeidhm an Pholasaí

- Beidh ar gach scoláire i mbliain 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 an éide foirmeálta a chaitheamh gach lá seachas ar an lá go mbíonn Corpoideachas ar siúl.
- Ní foláir do gach scoláire a bheith gléasta go néata, glan, slán, gan smideadh agus san éide scoile ceart (nó an éide spóirt mar is cuí) agus iad ar scoil nó ar aon turas nó imeacht eile a eagraíonn an scoil agus le linn na scrúduithe stáit.
- Tá cosc ar bhioráin aghaidhe – srón, beola, mala súl, srl.
- Sa chás go bhfuil tatú ar scoláire iarrtar air/uirthi é a chlúdach ar scoil nó ar aon ócáidí scoile.
- Is gá ingne a bheith gearr ar eagla gortú dóibh féin nó d'éinne eile agus níl cead ingne bréagacha a bheith ag aon scoláire.
- Caithfear an éide scoile cuí a chaitheamh ar thurais scoile agus ag ócáidí scoile i gcónaí ach sa chás go ndeirtear a mhalairt.
- Iarrtar ar ár scoláirí an Ghaeilge a labhairt le bród mar theanga chumarsáide agus an éide scoile á chaitheamh acu.
- Má thagann scoláire ar scoil gan an éide scoile ceart iarrfar air/uirthi éide scoile spáráilte ar fáil sa scoil a chur orthu don lá. Tógfar aon gheansaí nó baill éadaí eile nach cuid den éide scoile iad ón scoláire go dtí Aoine na seachtaine sin.
- Bronnfar pointí ar scoláirí ar bhonn éide scoile ceart a chaitheamh, de réir córas na bPointí atá i bhfeidhm sa scoil.
- Sa chás go mbíonn cúis dáiríre ag scoláire teacht ar scoil gan an éide scoile iomlán á chaitheamh ba cheart dó/di nóta mínithe agus sínithe ag tuismitheoir a thabhairt ar scoil ina thaobh.
- Bítear ag súil le comhoibriú gach scoláire i dtaobh cur i bhfeidhm an pholasaí seo. Sa chás nach gcloínn scoláire leis an bpolasaí d'fhéadfaí iarraidh ar na tuismitheoirí teacht chun na scoile chun an scéal a phlé.
- Bítear ag súil i gcónaí le comhoibriú tuismitheoirí maidir le cur i bhfeidhm an pholasaí seo.
- Beidh an polasaí seo curtha i bhfeidhm ag an bpríomhoide, múinteoirí, scoláirí, foireann riaracháin, agus tuismitheoirí.

6th Year 2024-25

School uniform is not compulsory. Practical, casual clothing is accepted; dressed as a professional worker. Students are expected to retain the formal school uniform to be worn for official school occasions.

Implementing the Policy

- *We expect all 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th 5th and 6th year students to wear the formal school uniform all school days except for PE day.*
- *All students must be neatly, cleanly and safely dressed without makeup and wearing the proper uniform (or the sports clothes if appropriate) while they are at school; or on any trip; or on any other outing that the school organises and during state examinations.*
- *While wearing the school uniform we ask our students to use their Irish and to be proud to do so.*
- *Face piercings are forbidden – nose, lips, eyebrow, etc.*
- *In the case where a student has a tattoo, he /she will be asked to cover it at school or on any school occasions.*
- *Nails need to be short in case of injury to themselves or anyone else and false nails are not permitted in school.*
- *Proper school uniform must always be worn on school trips and for school events unless otherwise stated.*
- *Should a student come to school without full school uniform he/she will be given spare school uniform to wear for the day. Jumpers and other items of clothing being worn in school that are not part of the school uniform shall be collected and retained in the school until Friday of that week.*
- *Points will be awarded to students on the basis of wearing the full uniform according to the Points System in place in the school.*
- *Should there be a genuine reason that a pupil comes to school without full school uniform he/she should bring a written signed explanation from his/her parents.*
- *We expect that all students fully comply with this policy. In the event that a student has difficulty with the policy the parents may be asked to come to the school to discuss the matter.*
- *We expect all parents to cooperate with the implementation of this policy.*

- *The practices in relation to the school uniform will be discussed often at staff meetings.*
